Penny Wars



From November 30 through December 11, Lincoln Elementary will be having "penny wars" between classrooms.

During this time, students put pennies and dollar bills in their classroom containers. This money is counted as positive. Silver coins are targeted in other classroom containers because this counts as negative money.

After Friday, December 11, each classroom container will be totaled. There will be two totals. The first is the total money collected. The second total adds the pennies and bills together and then subtracts the amount of silver change from it. This is the amount the classroom will have as their total amount.

The money collected goes to directly help local Zeeland families have a "Merry Christmas." Students who participate in this will receive a credit towards their "Generosity" character tag.

They provide girls with the tools necessary to make healthy decisions and the knowledge to lead healthy lifestyles. The 10 week curriculum offers lessons that specifically address some of the issues that will arise during elementary school. Teams of 8-15 girls will engage in in-depth, age appropriate discussions regarding topics such as bullying and gossiping, making healthy choices, keeping promises and self confidence to name a few. Teams meet twice a week with their trained, volunteer coaches to play games, complete projects and use the power of running to learn about themselves and others!
