Señora Darrow's Spanish Summary # 11

Students in kindergarten and first grade will watch puppet shows in Spanish and help find hidden objects, to practice prepositions (enfrente, atrás, detrás, arriba, and abajo) (in front, behind, up, and down). Students in second, third, fourth, and fifth grades will continue to review the nouns and adjectives before they make sentences. To review, students will sing songs, play games (such as flyswatter, where they play against someone to try and tap the picture before the other person). The goal is for students to know how to write and speak in compound sentences by the end of February.
