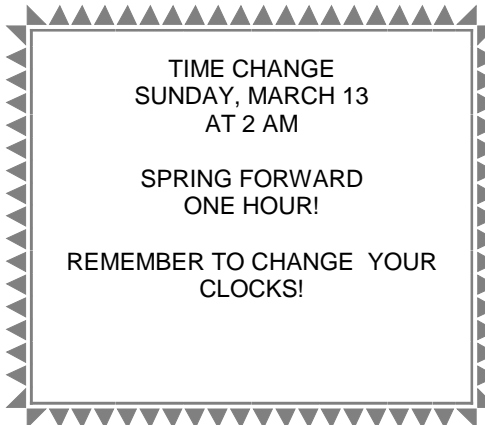

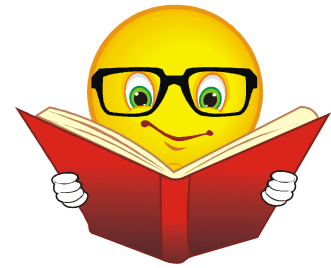

Spanish Summary #18

In kindergarten we are practicing numbers 1-30 by each student putting their numbers in order. In first grade we continue to learn school materials as we listen to a song play "Four Corners" (when students walk from big flashcard to big flashcard placed around the room and have to stop when they hear the name of the item called). Second graders are also practicing fruits and vegetables by playing the "Four Corners" game (as described above). In third grade, we will practice more words about body parts while working on Ipads and doing flashcards. Fourth graders will learn different hobbies and sports while playing the "Four Corner" game (as described above). Fifth graders will continue to learn to give directions and how to describe their community while playing the "Four Corner" game (as described above).
