The Spanish Immersion Kindergarten students are making sentences about animals, types of clothing and colors. The other kindergarten classes are learning how to form sentences about shapes using play dough. The 1st Grade Spanish Immersion students are making sentences using types of clothing and colors. The other 1st graders will learn how to present and speak about shapes they have made with play dough. In 2nd grade I will use technology and songs to teach sentences about the food vocabulary. The 3rd Grade Spanish Immersion class will begin to learn types of "ir" verbs and how to conjugate "ir" verbs. The other 3rd grade classes will learn body parts through technology and songs, they will also learn clothing vocabulary. 4th graders will learn how to write sentences about sports. 5th graders will write sentences about how to give directions around the city using songs & games.
