Spanish Summary #25

In the kindergarten and first grade Spanish Immersion class we will describe animals and objects. Third grade Spanish Immersion students will play bingo and board games using "ir" verbs. Kindergarten and first grade students will learn new activities and songs as they practice numbers. In second grade, I will read, "The Hungry Little Caterpillar" in Spanish. They will then use fruit manipulatives to practice saying the story themselves. Third graders will do relay races as we learn clothing words in Spanish. In fourth grade we will learn how to speak in paragraphs about sports. Fifth grade students will play bingo as we learn direction words.
