Please call in absences by 8:30 a.m. Even if you may have written a note to the teacher about your child's absence, please call the office or attendance line. If we do not receive a phone call from you, we will call you. It is important that we know where our students are!

We are required to report numbers of illnesses to the Health Department. Names of students are not used. To help us in this reporting, please indicate if your child has the flu (fever with any of the following symptoms: sore throat, cough, generalized aching in the back or limb muscles) OR a stomach virus (vomiting or diarrhea).

Also, if your child will be arriving late and needs a lunch, please leave the lunch choice (A, B, or C) on the attendance line. Lunches are ordered by 9:00 a.m. each day. If no lunch is ordered, the student must take his/her own lunch.

If Your Child Does Not Ride A Bus

- Students who are picked up will use the west entrance.
- Send a note to let your child's teacher know s/he will not ride the bus. They will then know to send the student to the west entrance to wait for you. In absence of a note, students will be placed on a bus.
- If you need to pick up your child after school, and your child does not know about being picked up, come to the office or call before 3:00 p.m. We'll get a message to your child's teacher so s/he can meet you by the west entrance.

A new bus tab is available on the Infinite Campus parent portal. Clicking on the tab provides the most current bus stop details for the student. Please sign up for parent portal by filling out the form available in the office. You will also be able to see your child's report card, attendance and any behavior issues recorded.

Crossing Guard Information

Parents: The City of Zeeland will once again offer Crossing Guard service to assist your children with crossing at the intersection of State Street and Central Avenue. This service will only be available school days from 8:05 a.m. to 8:35 a.m. in the morning and 3:30 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. in the afternoon. Parents, please speak with your child about the crossing guard and the importance of being there during service hours.

Medications At School Zeeland Public Schools Medication Policy

Zeeland Public Schools medication policy states that the Board will require the written prescription from the child's physician accompanied by the written authorization of the parent. This includes prescription and over the counter medication.

All medication must be brought to the office by a parent or guardian. Medicine is not allowed on the bus nor is it to be brought in by the student. All medication must be in its original prescription bottle with current dates and dosages matching the doctor's prescription.

Management plans must be on file for allergy, asthma, seizure, and diabetes management.

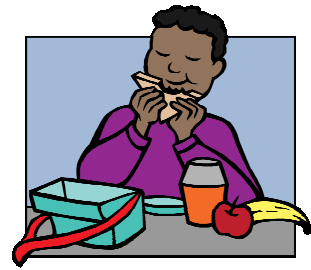
